## **PRIMARY SCRIPTURE:**

James 1:1-15, Matt 5:3-12, Heb. 12:1-3

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Read James 1:1-15 together. What jumps out at you? What pushes you around?
- 2. James was raised in a large family by a single mother. How might that have impacted his writings?
- 3. James did not believe in Jesus as Lord until after the Resurrection (John 7:3-5.) How might his 'late' conversion have impacted his writing?
- 4. The themes of this passage:
  - a) Trials are hard but helpful.
  - b) Wisdom is available to everyone who asks God for it.
  - c) Your financial situation is temporary. God's Kingdom is forever.
  - d) The time to flee temptation is always 'now' so it doesn't destroy you and you can do it.
