PRIMARY SCRIPTURE:

Mark 4: 35-41

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Let's talk about boats. Who likes to go out on a boat? Who doesn't? Who loves the water? Who is scared of the water? Any good boat stories out there? [Leader, please lead out with your answers]
2. This story gives us a good metaphor for some of the 'storms' we face in life. When you think of the reaction of the people on the boat because of the storm, where can you relate with them and in what ways do you react differently to storms in life?
3. The people on the boat called out to Jesus for help. How can calling on Jesus be significant to us today?
4. What does faith have to do with this? How does faith specifically help you through storms?
5. What happens when your faith cannot calm the storms in your life? What then? What happens when it feels like Jesus doesn't care about your circumstance?
6. Prayer — Let's spend some time in prayer. Would anyone be willing to share a storm you are going through or just simply that you are going through a storm right now, personally? We are also enduring a storm collectively through what is happening in the area of racial injustice and the COVID-19 crisis. Let's listen to one another share about these storms and then let's pray together, calling on Jesus to help.
