DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 4. What would your ideal mealtime routine look like? How many days a week for a family or group dinner? What is getting in the way of making your ideal mealtime a reality?
- 5. What is your normal approach to communion? What do you think it would look like to take the reflections from communion during our services and apply them to our everyday meals?
